- Control emissions and prevent pollution and nuisance
- Manage the production, reuse, recycling and disposal of waste
- Raise awareness of environmental issues in construction through training and development of all employees, suppliers and subcontractors
- Seek to reduce the environmental impact of projects by influencing client and design
- Set objectives and targets and regularly measure and communicate performance achieved
- Communicate this policy to everyone working for or on behalf of the company

This policy is given effect through an integrated management system that meets the requirements of ISO 14001:2004. BAM Nuttall is committed to the continual improvement and effectiveness of this system.

The board regards the responsibility of management in implementing this policy to be fundamental to BAM Nuttall's core business objectives. A director is appointed by the board as director responsible for environment to promote this policy and monitor the effectiveness of the company environmental management system.

Employees are made aware of the requirements of this policy on recruitment and a copy is available at every work location.

The policy is reviewed at least annually and revised when appropriate.
